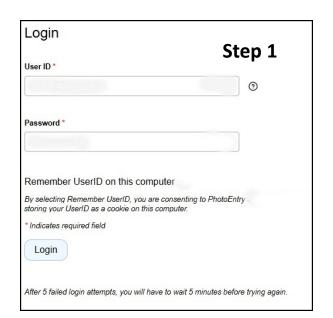

Instructions On How to Enter and Sign In to PhotoEntry

Uploading Images

To enter any of the competitions you Click on Login to Photo Entry. This is where you either register or sign in to set up your Password and ID. For New Members you will need to get your ID from the Competition Administrator by emailing hyettpeter@hotmail.co.uk

The following sample illustrations take you step by step through the procedures of Login and uploading your images..

From the Main Menu after login you will see a list of Competitions etc. for the current season

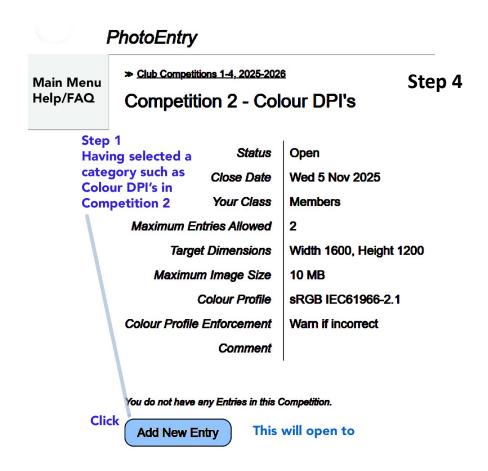
Note: each category (e.g. mono/colour Dpi or print) in a competition has its own line of entry: use them in turn to make your entry, adding one image at a time. Our contests/image sharing such as Show and Tell will specify how many entries that you are allowed to make.



However we may need to set priorities. Clubs are required to manage their competition entries to a maximum of about 70-75 each time. This is deemed to be a reasonable maximum for a typical club evening of about two hours. If there are too many images in a competition, we will remove the Priority 3's. If, on closure of a competition the Print Administrator finds the entry exceeding 76 images he will inform you that P3 will be dropped. This can be used for another competition.

How to Upload Images and Set Up Priority Images - As an example choose Competition 2 Colour Dpi's

- Click Club Competitions 1-4, 2025-2026
- Then click Competition 2 Colour DPI's
- Click 'Add New Entry'



- Put your image title in the red box (No Competition Number, underscore or name is needed)
- In Entry Reference enter your image Priority as P1, P2, or P3.

- Scroll down in 'Entry is Publishable'
 there is a 'Yes' change it to 'No' if
 you are not willing for the image to be
 published (e.g. in a newspaper or on
 EPG's Facebook page etc)
- Click 'Add This Entry'

Profile and Size

- In the next screen Click 'Choose JPEG'
- Then find your image, click on it, and click 'Open' – you will then see the file name appear and its size.
- Click the 'Upload Image' box:

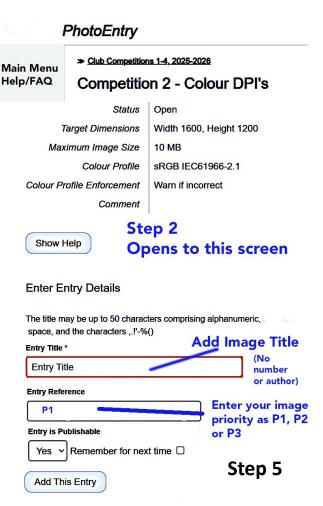

A couple of important points:

Please DO NOT USE either the BACK or REFRESH buttons – doing this may well cause you to lose data and return the system to a previous state. Please navigate using the PhotoEntry buttons provided, and logout when done. While a competition is 'Open' you can make changes e.g. delete an image and replace it with another one. Once a competition is 'Closed' the images are locked in.

Size & Profile

This will ask you to login, then another click for the competition. See the screen grabs below and click on the appropriate competition. It will be necessary to make sure your images have the right profile and the right size. The Competition Secretary has written some instructions on how to do this if you have Adobe Photoshop or Lightroom. To give an image the correct PROFILE and size:

In PHOTOSHOP -

Click on "File\Export\Export As...", Ensure Format is JPG, and Quality 100%. (If the image is being resized down to the target dimensions this is unlikely to be a problem in terms of file size). You now need to manually tweak the dimensions. First try setting the Image Size Width to 1600. If the Image Size Height now exceeds 1200, set it to 1200 (the width should drop down accordingly). Default resampling is Bicubic Automatic. Try this first and if not happy experiment with others. Ensure "Convert to sRGB" is checked. Click "Export All..." and select where you want the exported image saved.

In LIGHTROOM -

In the Library view, click on "Export..." In the "File Settings" section: Set "Image Format" to "JPEG". Set "Quality" to 100. (If the image is being resized down to the target dimensions this is unlikely to be a problem in terms of file size). Set "Colour Space" to "sRGB". Ensure "Limit File Size To:" is un-checked.

In the Image Sizing section: Ensure "Resize to Fit" is checked. Choose the "Width & Height" option. Set the "W:" and "H:" values to 1600 and 1200, and the units to "pixels". Set "Resolution" to 300 pixels per inch. Ensure "Don't Enlarge" is checked

Don't forget, there is an area called Images for External Competitions where you can enter/store images that may be suitable for our External Competitions and Events. We need a variety of prints and digital images.
